Trips, Lessons, Special Event Days

WATER WIZZ TRIPS

On scheduled trip days, Trip Campers report directly to their Hill Assembly by 8:45am. Hill Heads dismiss Trip Campers from assembly. Please send your child with a backpack containing the following items:

LESSONS

➤ **Semi-Private Swim Lesson, in BDC pool - Mondays and Tuesdays, 1:00PM**

On your child's semi-private swim lesson day, she/he should come to camp with an extra swim suit and towel. Your child will be placed in a small group by level and ability for their 30 minute lesson. "Dry swim lessons" will take place in a warm/dry location on rainy/chilly days. Semi-Private Swim Lessons are not rescheduled due to inclement weather.

➤ **Tennis Lesson, at a private tennis court in South Orleans - Tuesday, 1:15PM**

On your child's tennis lesson day, she/he should come to camp with a pair of athletic shoes, hat, sun screen, and his/her own tennis racket. Tennis lessons are approximately 45 minutes long. Tennis balls will be provided. *BDC does not provide tennis rackets.* Please make sure that your child brings his/her own tennis racket. Campers are transported to the off campus private tennis court by the BDC bus with the BDC tennis instructor. The bus departs BDC by 1pm and returns to campus by 2:15pm. "Dry tennis lessons" will take place in a warm/dry location on rainy days. Semi-Private Tennis Lessons are not rescheduled due to inclement weather.

➤ **Horseback Riding Lesson, at Woodsong Farm in Brewster - Wednesdays, 2:30-3, 3-3:30PM**

On your child's riding lesson day, she/he should come to camp prepared to participate following Woodsong Farm's safety and quality instruction policies. Campers will be transported to Woodsong Farm by the BDC bus for their individual half hour lesson. The bus departs BDC by 2pm and returns to campus by 4pm. Your child is with a BDC staff person while waiting for his/her lesson. To participate in a riding lesson at Woodsong Farm each camper *must*:

- Provide a signed release form prior to the first lesson. This form can only be signed by the child's legal guardian or parent. A Riding Release Form is enclosed.
- Wear long pants and heeled shoes (preferably riding boots). Pants and heeled shoes may be stored in your child's tent at camp.
- Wear a riding helmet - the barn will provide helmets but suggests that each rider purchase his/her own helmet.

****Please return the Horseback Riding Release Form to the BDC Office BEFORE your child's first lesson day.*

➤ **Golf Lesson, at the Captains Course in Brewster - Thursdays, 12:45-1:45**

On your child's golf lesson day, she/he should come to camp with a pair of athletic shoes, windbreaker or rain coat (if needed), hat and/or sunscreen. *Golf clubs and balls are provided by the instructor.* If your child would prefer to use his/her own golf clubs, these clubs are to be dropped off at the BDC Office the day of the lesson. Due to limited storage space and safety, golf clubs may only remain in the BDC Office on the day of the lesson. Golf clubs must only be picked up and dropped off from the BDC Office. Golf Lessons take place rain or shine.

➤ **BDC Sailing School, at Cliff Pond – M/W/T/TH, Friday Races optional but included, 12:30-4:30PM**

On your child's Sailing School days, he/she should come to camp with a bathing suit, pair of water shoes, windbreaker, hat and sun screen. Life jackets will be provided by BDC, however, if your child has a favorite PFD, he/she may bring this Personal Floatation Device to BDC. If your child is attending Sailing School only, he/she must be at the BDC Office by 12:30 to meet the instructors and catch the BDC Shuttle Bus to the BDC Waterfront. Otherwise you are responsible for transportation to Nickerson State Park and walking with your camper to the BDC Waterfront. Sailors return to BDC Office by 4:30PM. "Dry sailing lessons" will take place in a warm/dry location on rainy days. Sailing Lessons are not rescheduled due to inclement weather.

SPECIAL EVENT DAYS

Campers may add a Special Event Day to their partial schedule. These Special Event Day campers should come to camp by 8:45 and report directly to their Hill Head to be included in the day's activity.

Please Note: All Extras are held rain or shine. Lessons, Trips, and Special Event Days missed for any reason may not be rescheduled, refunded, or exchanged.
